JOB ANNOUNCEMENT
Lieutenant/EMT/Training Officer

The Evans Valley Fire District #6 is seeking candidates for a permanent full-time Lieutenant/EMT/Training Officer position. The Evans Valley Fire District operates one station within its 26 square mile fire district; and serves a population of approximately 4,000 citizens. The fire district provides fire protection, first response EMS and rescue to its mostly rural/wild land interface community. We respond to approximately 350 emergency alarms per year.

A Lieutenant at the Evans Valley Fire District performs as a firefighter/EMT and an officer. There is only one paid line position at this fire district. The position also performs all other related duties as assigned. The position requires that you have good communication skills and be a team player. Salary range for the position is \$2,500.00 to \$2,974.00 per month depending on qualifications. The benefit package includes PERS, health and dental insurance, sick leave and vacation time.

The purpose of this recruitment is to fill one existing opening.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be at least 21 years of age
- Must be a high school graduate, possess a GED or equivalent experience
- Must be a current National Registered or Oregon EMT-Basic & obtain EMT-Intermediate within one (1) year of employment. (subject to course availability)
- Must be currently certified as NFPA Firefighter I
- Must be currently certified as NFPA Pump Operator
- Must be currently certified as NFPA Instructor I
- Must have basic computer skills (Office Applications)
- Must possess or obtain a valid Oregon drivers license and be insurable by employment start date. Must have possessed a driver's license for at least two (2) years at the time of employment.
- Must be able to perform mental and physical task pursuant to essential functions of the position.
- Must possess two (2) years experience as a structural firefighter

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- AAS Degree in fire science or other Fire/EMS related field
- Oregon EMT-Intermediate
- DPSST Fire Ground Leader
- Education & experience in volunteer recruitment issues
- Basic mechanical skills (light truck)
- Wildland firefighting skills and experience

MEDICAL – PHYSICAL CONDITION:

If offered employment, appointee must undergo criminal and DMV background checks, drug testing, medical/physical exam, and pass-fail physical capability exam. Appointee must also be able to pass OSHA medical evaluation/SCBA fit-test exam.

Any of the following may be cause for the discontinuation of employment: 1) drug testing that identifies positive results of illegal drug or alcohol use. 2) Failure to successfully complete the physical capability exam or medical/physical exam.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS:

Residency will not be a general requirement of employment in this position with the fire district; however, employees are encouraged to live within the fire district.

TRIAL SERVICE PERIOD:

New employee shall serve a trial service period of one (1) year commencing with their first day of employment. During this period, the employee shall be evaluated each quarter to determine if further employment with this fire district is appropriate.

“AT WILL” POSITION

An employee in this position will understand that employment and compensation can be terminated at any time.

FLSA POSITION:

An employee in this position is not allowed to be a volunteer with this district. FLSA rules state that an employee may not volunteer back their employing agency to do the same job for which he/she receives salary. However, that does not prohibit an employee to provide assistance in other ways, such as support functions.

ABOUT THE SELECTION PROCESS:

To apply, submit an application and resume to the address below. Resumes without an application will not be considered. Applications with resumes must be received by **5:00pm, September 11, 2009.**

Finalist will be selected from the group of qualified applicants. Interviews and/or conversations with personal references and others may be used to assist in the selection of finalists. Those selected will be invited to participate in the employment process described separately.
