**CHIEF'S REPORT:**

- This past month 32 alarms were reported. This brings the total to 224 alarms for 2022, which is an increase of 43 alarms from this time last year. The call breakdown is as follows - EMS 15, Fire 1, Public Assist 4, MVC 3, Mutual Aids 8, Missed calls 1.
- Update on apparatus replacement - After soliciting a couple of bids, we're going to go with a local company which is Cascade Fire. We'll be putting this whole project together for the next board meeting.
- We got the West Family Foundation grant for \$10,000. Which will help with the upfit for the new truck.
- We also submitted another grant to the State of Oregon requesting \$36,000 to help offset the cost of part-time firefighters for the summer. This will allow us to hire four seasonal firefighters.
- The budget, already approved by the budget committee, goes to the board next week for final approval.
- We're working on changing our supplier of propane from Blue Star to Farrellgas, which will be about half the cost.
- SOREDI, an organization that helps community partners to solve funding and staffing problems is going to provide us with a professional grant writer to put together a plan for us to find long term funding solutions including grants.
