**CHIEF'S REPORT:**

- We applied for a grant of \$35,000 from the State of Oregon for part-time firefighters and we were approved. We have all four positions filled for the summer.
- Pharrell Gas - We are in the process of switching out the tanks.
- Chief finished his Fire officer 3 and 4 certifications, so he is now a Fire Officer 4.
- This past month 33 alarms were reported. This brings the total to 257 alarms for 2022, which is an increase of 23 calls from this time last year. The call breakdown is as follows - EMS 19, Fire 1, Public Assist 7, MVC 2, Mutual Aid 4, Missed calls 0.
- Bryce Cables is volunteer of the month.
